Introduction: Our Father who art in Heaven

1st Petition: Hollowed be Thy name. [On earth as it is in heaven]
2nd Petition: Thy Kingdom come. [On earth as it is in heaven]
3rd Petition: Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

4th Petition: Give us this day our daily bread

5th Petition: Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us.

6th Petition: Lead us not into temptation.
7th Petition: But deliver us from evil.

Conclusion: For thine is the Kingdom and the power and glory forever and ever. Amen

There are 3 main parts to the Lord's Prayer

Introduction

7 Petitions

Conclusion – which is not part of the prayer in scripture.

There are 3 main areas to the 7 Petitions of the Lord's Prayer

- 1-3 What God wants to happen in the world as in heaven
- 4 Deals with our material needs
- 5-7 Deals with the area of sin and the evil one

Note: Only one petition deals with material needs. What might this indicate as to what is most important to God?
